The Home Care Aide is responsible for providing support to the Home Care Nurse, as well as Alexis Nakota Sioux Nation community members who are registered with the Home Care program. The right candidate for this position must be able to work effectively in a collaborative team environment. Must have professional conduct and appearance in keeping with a representative of the Alexis Health Services, which includes excellent performance related to personnel policies such as attendance, punctuality, and conflict resolution.

DUTIES / RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Charting, filing, and data entry
- Home Care client follow-up, assist with medical concerns and/or appointments
- Home visits with Home Care nurse or with other nursing staff
- Training when required
- Monitor work plans to ensure duties/tasks are being met each fiscal year
- Complete and submit reports in collaboration with Home Care and Health staff
