Student Profile:

Alexis Nakota Sioux Nation Education supports 110 students in Grades 7-12. Our current graduation rates are 3 - 5 per year. We currently have 67 students in Grades 7-9 and 43 in Grades 10-12, however attendance is inconsistent.

Our Goal:

To find a passionate, innovative, enthusiastic certified teacher to redesign and create an Experiential Learning Education Program for Alexis Nakota Middle and Secondary students that honor their strengths and current learning challenges.

Our Need:

In your proposal, please complete the following:

- a) Copy of your TQS, Years of Service, CRIM, CWIS, References
- b) Environmental scan of current students in Grades 7-12 including hobbies, interests, literacy levels, attendance, diagnosis and family supports
- c) Snapshot of provincial junior and senior high programs *that are serving similar populations* and the characteristics of the program that have proven to be successful including timelines for this program's implementation (When did they start implementing the strategy? How are they measuring the program's success? How are the students involved in the program delivery or design?)
- d) Proposed project and implementation plan for junior high school that meets cultural identity of the Nation and provincial outcomes for Grades 7-9 Program of Studies.
- e) Proposed project and implementation plan for senior high school that meets cultural identity of the Nation and the provincial outcomes for Grades 10-12 Program of Studies including completion of high school diploma for ALL students.
- f) Requested Resources - human, curriculum, professional development required to implement the programs
- g) Proposed implementation team for this intervention to be successful (who do we need involved to change the nature and culture of our secondary school culture?)
- h) Your strengths to lead this work – What makes you well-suited to design and lead this work?

- Must be able to teach compulsory high school subjects
- Preference will be given to those with experience working with First Nations children and families;
- Must be respectful of Nakota Sioux culture, traditions and language
- Must have a clear Criminal Record Check and Child-Welfare Check
