The First Nation Band Representative Worker is a highly motivated individual with exceptional advocacy skills, possessing knowledge of the Child Youth and Family Enhancement Act and its application for the First Nation Children and its members. The goal of this position is to be the advocate for our children and our families ensuring they never lose their culture and identity.

Qualifications and Requirements:

- Social Work Diploma, Bachelor of Social Work degree, or a degree in a relevant field, or a combination of education and experience in a similar role.
- Experience with Case Management and working in a prevention or intervention role with Child and Family Services.
- Knowledgeable of the Child Youth and Family Enhancement Act, Alberta Provincial Legislation as well as other provinces, in relation to Children Services.
- Experience in advocacy.
- Ability to maintain a high level of confidentiality and discretion.
- Demonstrated organizational skills and ability to multi-task.
- Experience with Microsoft Office (Outlook, Word, Excel, and PowerPoint).
- Ability to work in a fast paced and constantly changing environment.
- Must be able to work outside of our regular business hours when required.
- Understanding of Nakota Sioux Nation's culture and identity.
